AGE CATEGORIES

For the Games, your age is determined as of December 31, 2024. In line with the sport-specific rules, an athlete can compete in a younger age group; however, can only enter one age category and one bow type.

If there are insufficient entries in an age category, they may be combined in order to conduct a viable competition.

- Men's: 30+, 40+, 50+, 60+, 70+
- Women's: 30+, 40+, 50+, 60+, 70+
- Para: 30+

RULES

The Archery competition will be conducted according to the rules of the World Archery Federation. The competition will also conform to the requirements of the International Masters Games Association (IMGA), unless otherwise specified in this document.

Technical Delegate

The World Archery Federation has endorsed the appointment of _____ to act in the role of Technical Delegate for the PAMG Archery competition. The Technical Delegate will oversee the implementation of all sport specific rules and requirements at the Games.

EQUIPMENT

Each competitor must provide his/her own equipment. It will not be possible to ship equipment to the venue.

Equipment permitted according to World Archery Rules.

Equipment inspections will take place Thursday, July 11 and Friday, July 12.

A detailed schedule of events will be published at a later date.







REGISTRATION & DEADLINES

Registration includes entry in up to three sports, 5 disciplines or events. Due to potential conflicts, it is the athlete's responsibility to determine if the competition schedule permits sport-specific entries.

LICENSE / MEMBERSHIP

It is recommended that athletes are affiliated through their member associations to World Archery; however, this is not compulsory to compete.

MEDALS

In Pan-American Masters Games, the athletes represent themselves rather than their country of origin, therefore the prize-awarding ceremonies will be carried out without the hoisting of flags or playing of national anthems.

Gold, Silver, and Bronze medals will be awarded to the first, second, and third place finishers for individuals in each age category per event.

If there are insufficient entries in an age category, categories may be combined in order to conduct a viable competition. The awarding of medals will not be affected, that is, individuals will still be awarded medals in the age category in which they originally entered.
